



Midge Flowers Cup

The Midge Flowers Cup was created in 2016 as a memorial competition to recognise and honour the commitment of our associations first Life member Mary 'Midge' Flowers after she passed on 27th May 2016.

Midge was a founding member of the WADA committee, and she committed over a decade of service to the Western Area Darts Association as an administrator and committee person. Midge continued to play for many seasons and was active in our association right up to her passing.

A popular figure among our membership community, at the oche, Midge could be considered a giant killer, as her list of "victims" taken down on the boards was extensive. Results will show, many a player of greater ability would often underestimate our pocket dynamo and finish on the wrong side of the ledger in WADA competition.

Midge was a strong advocate of Association Knock Out Cups during her time of governance, so the management committee of 2016/17 believed this was the best way in which our association could honour the life of Midge and her service and contribution to The Western Area Darts Association.

The Midge Flowers Cup is a teams-based knockout format where all teams compete in the one competition pool, with a handicap scoring system to balance out the teams of differing abilities. First played in the Summer Season of 2017, the inaugural Midge Flowers Cup was won by The Cougars, a team consisting of many high achieving South Australian State Representatives, all of whom competed with a determination to ensure they were inaugural winners of "The Midge", such was the regard our membership held for Midge.

To this day The Midge Flowers Cup is a strongly contested competition which allows our members to remember a great of our association and share loving memories with new members to ensure her legacy is shining bright long into the future.

Midge Midge Flowers Cup Guidelines

- 1. All games are compulsory for WADA registered teams.
- 2. All games are played on the 15 game playing format.
- 3. The winner is the first team to win eight(8) Games
- 4. The Lower average team will always play 601 doubles and 501 singles. The Higher average team will be advised of their starting score for both doubles and singles for each night of play.
- 5. Handicap Scoring for each match will be sent to each competing captain and both must agree the handicap score for doubles and singles prior to commencement of play.
- 6. All games are played under official WADA rules.
- 7. The winning team progresses through to next round and losing team is eliminated from future rounds of Midge Flowers Cup.
